ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Have the proven ability to shoe horses, hot or cold
- Treat horses for minor injuries, vaccinate, etc.
- Feed, groom, and saddle horses
- Two rides daily 1-2+ hours each
- Conduct rides in a safe and courteous manner as instructed by Foreman
- Clean and mend tack
- Keep holding pens and tack house area clean and organized
- Trail cleaning and brush removal.
- Train colts, riding new horses
- Drive stick shift
- Attend staff and department meetings

GENERAL:

- Ability to be flexible and follow direction from ranch management
- Strong and positive communication skills
- Attend staff and department meetings
- Any staff member may be asked to supervise children during meals.
- The above list is not all-inclusive. The duties and responsibilities of this position may be changed from time to time by the ranch managers.

Physical Requirements:

Standing, walking, lifting up to 50 lbs., climbing, stooping, kneeling, seeing, crouching, crawling, reaching, speaking and hearing. Must be able to reach with arms extended above head for periods of time.

The position requires excellent physical condition and stamina. Hours tend to be irregular and long. Extended periods of work without time off may be required.
